Notice of Decision to Open Three Ishinkan Facilities

Amvis, Inc. (Chuo-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director and CEO: Keiichi Shibahara) has decided to open three Ishinkan facilities in April, July, and August 2023. With these openings, the number of Ishinkan facilities will be 71 (3,520 beds), exceeding the target of 70 (3,411 beds) set in our three-year plan, “Amvis 2023.”

In the fiscal year ending September 30, 2023, we are accelerating deployment in the Tokyo metro area where demand is high. At the same time, we plan to continue expanding into regional cities which have high barriers to entry.

After opening these facilities, we will have thirteen Ishinkan in Kanagawa prefecture and eight in Tokyo.

As medical care shifts from hospital-based to community-based care, we aim to strengthen regional healthcare by proactively opening Ishinkan in areas with high needs for chronic and terminal care.

Overview of Ishinkan, Operated by the Amvis Group

Ishinkan is a healthcare facility in which nurses and other caregivers provide round-the-clock care. Ishinkan actively accepts patients who are in the terminal stage of cancer, who are on respirators, who have had tracheostomies, who have specific diseases requiring them to be repeatedly in and out of hospital, or who require end-of-life nursing and caregiving. Ishinkan actively cooperates with regional medical institutions, pharmacies, and nursing care facilities, and functions as “shared hospital beds.”
