Notice of the Impact of NHI Care and Medical Service Fee Revisions on Our Financial Performance

Details of NHI care and medical service fee revisions for FY2024 were announced, based on deliberations by the committee on Care Benefits of the Social Security Council on January 22, 2024, and a report by the Central Social Insurance Medical Council on February 14, 2024. Amvis Holdings, Inc. (Chuo-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director and CEO: Keiichi Shibahara) outlines the impact of these revisions on its consolidated financial performance below.

NHI Care and Medical Service Fee Revisions in Relation to Our Business

The FY2024 revisions are simultaneous revisions of medical service and care fees in light of recent price hikes and rising wages, as well as a decrease in working-age population. The issues raised in the report include deepening and promoting the Community-based Integrated Care System in accordance with regional conditions, securing human resources and promoting work style reform in light of the current employment situation in the medical and care industries, which face a significant labor shortage, and ensuring the stability and sustainability of the system, with a view to the ideal future medical and care delivery systems to realize a sustainable social security system oriented to all generations.

In these revisions, the number of units has been changed and newly established in accordance with the optimization and focus of evaluation. Also, fees for providing services to patients of the same building and others were revised. Meanwhile, the evaluation of providers who provide services to severely ill patients such as in end-of-life stage was reviewed in order to ensure high-quality home healthcare and home nursing care. Furthermore, a new evaluation of medical DX promotion was established for the purpose of effective use of medical information. Also, several other requirements have been revised to steadily promote the division of roles and seamless cooperation between medical and care treatment. In addition, it was decided to further promote measures to improve compensation for nurses and caregivers who support the medical and care fields, with the aim of increasing their wages.

Impact on Financial Performance

At this time, the impact of NHI care and medical service fee revisions on our consolidated financial performance has both positive and negative aspects, but the overall impact is expected to be immaterial, and if any matters that should be disclosed arise in the future, they will be announced promptly.
